
Rachel leveraged their strong relationships to gain an additional \$100,000 in Corporate Gala Sponsorships.

Employee Personal Donations:

Our goal is to encourage everyone on the Rachel Team to get involved and give back to those who need help the most. Rachel Contracting will match employee donations and time invested into community non-profits. The matching funds will then be invested back into our communities where we work, live and play.

- If Employees make personal donations into non-profit organizations, Rachel Contracting will match 100% of these funds up to \$250 per employee each year into the Rachel Foundation.
- If Employees volunteer their personal time for non-profit organizations,
 Rachel Contracting will match the first 5 hours of time at the value of \$50/hr
 up to \$250 per employee each year into the Rachel Foundation.



The Vagle Family has enjoyed giving back to their local community in many ways over the years. They believe that teaching their children to be grateful and to help others is one of the best paths to personal happiness. Some of the ways they have given back are; monthly volunteering at the Monticello Help Center where they pack food for the monthly community food drives, making and donating Tie Blankets to the Monticello Cancer Center on Martin Luther King's Annual Day of Service, delivering Meal on Wheels to local Monticello/Big Lake residents several times a year, packing Birthday Bags for local children through the Monticello Help Center, donating portions of weekly chore allowance and 100% of summer lemonade stand proceeds to the local Giving Tree through our Church who distributes the donations then disadvantaged local youth, donating time to stock shelves at CROSS Services in Rogers, and donating about a half dozen deer hides annually to the local Minnesota Deer Hunters' Association Hides for Habitat Program. Not only do their volunteer efforts and donations help those in need but it has also has had the added effect of creating a great family bonding time that is hard to come by in today's hustle and bustle!
