We've adopted a highway in St. Michael, MN. Managing Highway clean up twice a year!




Holiday Heroes

Employee Match Program

Rachel Employees donated their time and money to local community non-profits. Rachel Contracting matched a total of \$13,200 of funds that went to the Rachel Foundation.



Employee Personal Donations:

Our goal is to encourage everyone on the Rachel Team to get involved and give back to those who need help the most. Rachel Contracting will match employee donations and time invested into community non-profits. The matching funds will then be invested back into our communities where we work, live and play.

- If Employees make personal donations into non-profit organizations, Rachel Contracting will match 100% of these funds up to \$250 per employee each year into the Rachel Foundation.
- If Employees volunteer their personal time for non-profit organizations,
 Rachel Contracting will match the first 5 hours of time at the value of \$50/hr
 up to \$250 per employee each year into the Rachel Foundation.

This committee is in charge of the Black Ice Jig. Tonya, her husband Nick and son Brayden have been involved since the first event in 2022. The 3rd annual event her father and brother also volunteered: her father even flew in from Texas for the event! The Binsfeld family has donated to Tonya's sister and brother in laws nonprofit organization, the Stand By Me Foundation. This charity was created when their son was diagnosed with brain cancer in May 2019 and passed January 2020. The charity helps other families with children 21 and younger who have cancer. Seeing three generations of her family volunteering, giving back, and instilling a core value makes her proud. It is one of their families' traits from generation to generation in being a healthy, happy individual by supporting and making good efforts to others. Unforeseeable hardships bring the family to a full circle on why they give back in the first place. Tonya has always cared, encouraged and supported their local community wherever the need may be.
